Subject: Request for Clarification on the Status of the 400 MW Temporary Generation Contract

Dear Executive Director Zapata:

LUMA Energy LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC, in our capacity as the Puerto Rico Transmission and Distribution System ("T&D System") Operator pursuant to the Transmission and Distribution Operation and Maintenance Agreement ("T&D OMA"),¹ respectfully submit this communication to request urgent clarification regarding its 400 MW Temporary Generation Contract ("Temporary Generation Agreement").

During a meeting held on August 3, 2026,² PREPA informed LUMA that the agreement with Power Expectations regarding the 400 MW Temporary Generation Contract was fully approved and required no amendments³. Shortly after this representation, however, serious developments emerged that call into question the current standing of the Temporary Generation Agreement.

These events introduce substantial uncertainty regarding the validity of the Temporary Generation Agreement and materially conflict with PREPA's assurance given to LUMA on August 3. The issues require careful and immediate consideration, particularly as they relate to contract approval and the identification of properly authorized parties.

Given the seriousness of these matters, LUMA respectfully requests PREPA's formal written confirmation regarding the current status of the Temporary Generation Agreement. In addition, LUMA requests clear guidance on PREPA's position moving forward, including confirmation of the authorized parties to the contract.

Until LUMA receives official written clarification from PREPA confirming the Temporary Generation Agreement's validity, approval status, and authorized contract parties, LUMA will not proceed with this project evaluations, including all interconnection related activities, nor will LUMA proceed in any

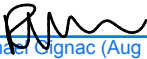
